City of Spruce Grove Fire Services, a fully integrated Fire/EMS service, has several casual firefighter positions available.

Casual firefighters work an “on call” system for fire and medical emergencies as well as being scheduled for shifts in the station to provide Spruce Grove with Fire and Emergency Medical protection.

Minimum Qualifications

- 18 years of age or older,
- Valid Class 4 drivers license (driver license abstract to be provided),
- Able to provide a current police security clearance check,
- Be in good health,
- Completion of NFPA 1001 Firefighter Qualifications. (Not required for EMT-P candidates)
- Registered with Alberta College of Paramedics as EMT-A or EMT-P.

Candidates will be tested for aptitude and physical fitness. All successful candidates will be required to undergo a training program prior to being appointed as a Casual Firefighter for the City of Spruce Grove.

These are Out-of-Scope positions; however pay is in accordance with City Policy, which ties the Casual Firefighter’s pay to the Firefighter’s Collective Agreement.
