Reporting to the Supervisor of Parks, employees in this position perform semi-skilled manual work and operate vehicles and limited equipment in accomplishing all operations and maintenance tasks assigned in delivering the prescribed programs and services in the Parks Division of the City. An incumbent receives oral and written instructions from a supervisor who evaluates the work performed. Employees in this position may occasionally be responsible for the task coordination of employees assigned as helpers (team leader) and are to promote a positive, secure and safe work environment.

REQUIRED TRAINING AND EXPERIENCE:

1. A minimum of one year of experience in the tasks and operation of equipment assigned to the position.
2. Completion of the twelfth school grade or GED supplemented by experience in tasks and the operation of equipment assigned to the position or equivalent combination of training and experience.
3. Possession of a valid Alberta Class 3 Motor Vehicle Operator's License mandatory; Class 3Q would be an asset.
4. Certification in Parks & Sportsfield Level 1 and/or Prairie Horticulture Certificate (Landscaping and Arboriculture) and/or Turfgrass Management Level 1 and/or Natural Ice and/or Pesticide Applicator's License would be an asset.
5. WHMIS, CPR, Transportation of Dangerous Goods and First Aid certification would be an asset.
6. Diploma or certification in a team leader or leadership course would be an asset.
