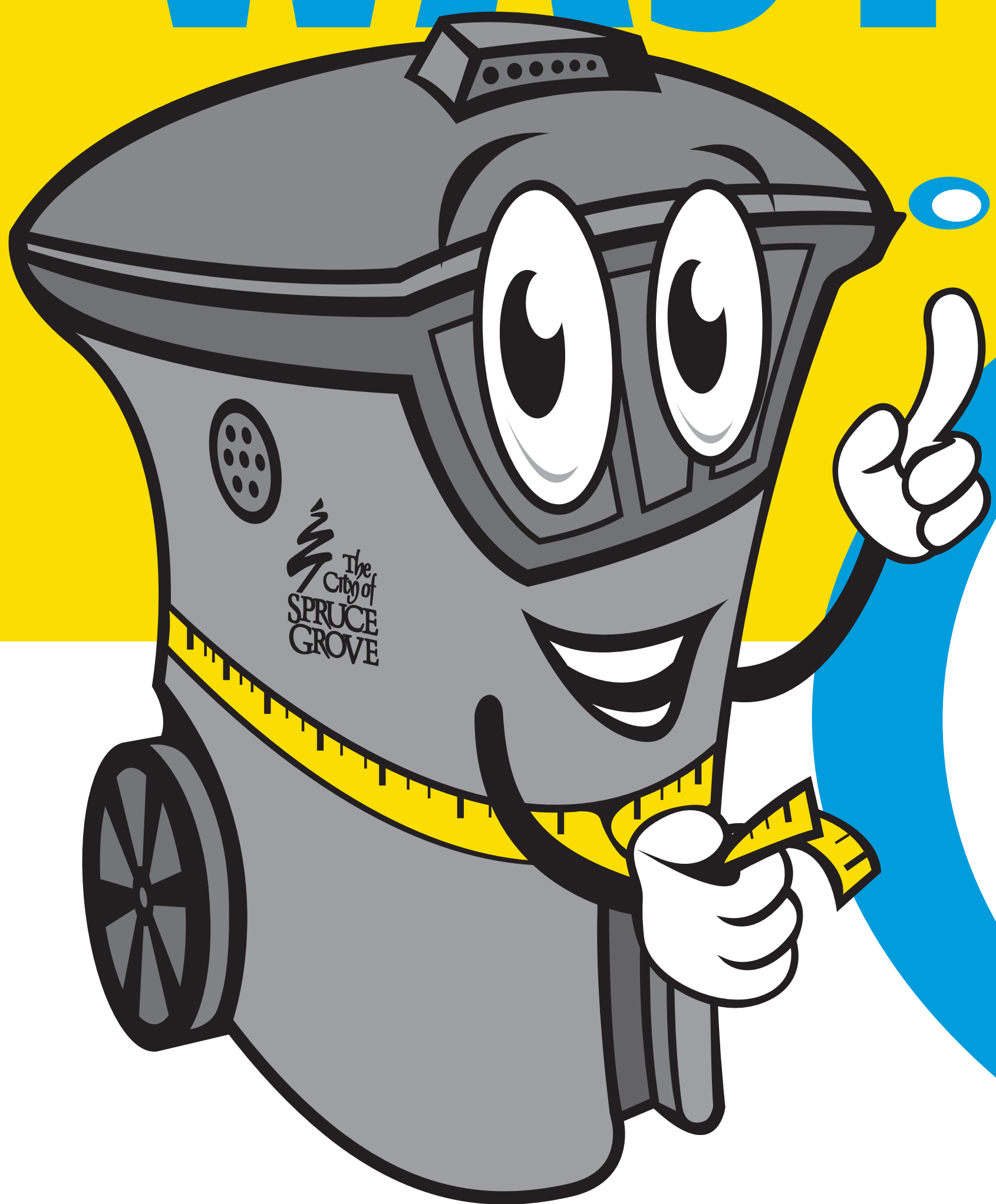


REDUCE YOUR WASTELINE



There is a waste limit in Spruce Grove. So I am on a mission to **REDUCE MY WASTE LINE.** My black bin capacity is 240 litres. You can help me stay under my limit by diverting waste.

DID YOU KNOW up to 75% of a typical household's waste can either be reused or recycled?

Here are the options available to you...

ORGANICS

Food and yard waste is picked up weekly from April to November on your regular collection day. The collected material is composted at a nearby facility.

The following material can be diverted into the Organicart:

- Vegetable and fruit peels
- Egg shells
- Meat, bones, and fat trimmings
- Coffee grinds
- Grass clippings, leaves, weeds, and garden foliage
- Tree prunings and brush

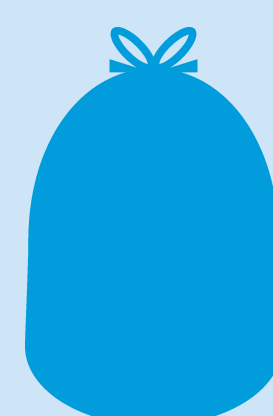


RECYCLING

Household recyclables are picked up every two weeks on your regular collection day.

The following recyclable items can be diverted into blue bags:

- Mixed Paper
- Boxboard
- Cardboard
- Milk jugs/cartons
- Tin cans and glass jars
- Plastic containers (#1-7)



ECO-CENTRE

The following items will be accepted at the Spruce Grove Eco-Centre (charges may apply):

- Paint
- Household cleaners
- Batteries
- Old appliances
- Computers and electronics



After you have filled the Organicart and blue bags, you may wonder what is left for the **black bin.** Here are some examples: • Diapers • Styrofoam • Cat litter and dog droppings • Unmarked plastic

Each household in Spruce Grove receives one **Green Bin for organic waste** and one **Black Bin for garbage.**
