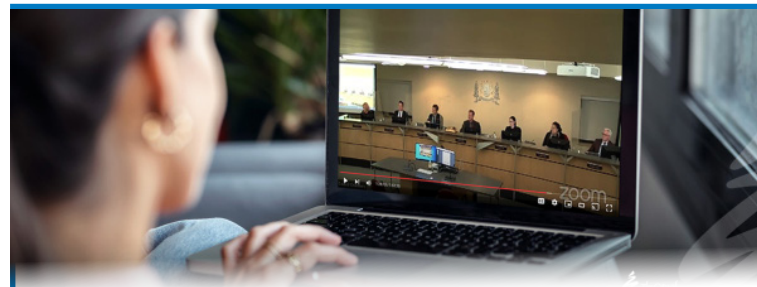

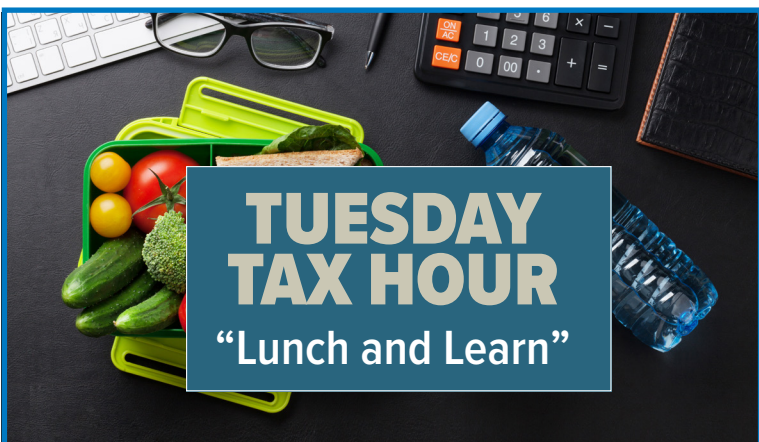


## Regular Council meeting
