## News You Can Use

### New Transit Centre opening December 2, 2024

In conjunction with the development of Heavy Metal Place, the City of Spruce Grove is building a new Spruce Grove Transit Centre to meet the growing transportation needs of our community, which will open to transit riders on Monday, December 2, 2024.



Located at 50 Westwind Drive, the Transit Centre will serve as the hub for all commuter service (Route 560) into and out of Spruce Grove and be a regular stop for the On-Demand Local Transit service, providing patrons of Heavy Metal Place another way to get there and enjoy all its amenities.

It will provide comfort and convenience for transit users, including parking stalls for Park & Ride users at no cost, a passenger drop off/pick up zone, bike racks, and a heated shelter where riders can wait for their bus.

Construction of Heavy Metal Place will still be underway at this time, with an anticipated facility opening in early 2025. This will not impact the operation of the Transit Centre or ability to access Park & Ride parking stalls, but the number of parking stalls will temporarily be limited to approximately 50 stalls in the southeast corner of the site. Once Heavy Metal Place is complete, a total of 600 parking stalls will become available for Park & Ride users at no cost.

By locating these two major facilities close together, the City can maximize the land usage and provide shared parking for both Heavy Metal Place and the Transit Centre.

### Seasonal RV & ATV parking timelines

Whether you like to travel the Rockies in your RV or explore nature on your ATV, you'll need a place to park these vehicles throughout the year, and we've recently made changes to extend RV parking time frames!

- RVs can now be parked on private property from April 15 to November 30 each year (previously May 1 to October 21). This includes RVs, motor homes, boats, campers and travel trailers.
- ATVs with tracks, such as snowmobiles, can continue to be parked from November 15 to April 15, each year.

During these times, RVs and ATVs can be parked on private, residential property in Spruce Grove. For the rest of the year, they must be stored elsewhere in an appropriate location or facility. Residents should ensure vehicles are clear of sidewalks and roadways to avoid blocking driver sightlines and to provide pedestrians enough room to walk by.
