WHY EPR MATTERS TO YOU

EPR shifts the cost and responsibility of recycling from local municipalities and taxpayers to the producers of recyclable materials.

This model holds producers accountable for the products they generate, recognizing that they are best positioned to influence product design and advance a circular economy.

Alberta is Launching With TWO Material Streams Designated Under EPR:

1

Single-Use Products, Packaging, and Paper Products (PPP)

This stream includes materials made from paper, flexible plastic, rigid plastic, metal, and glass.

Hazardous and Special Products (HSP)

This stream covers items such as batteries, pesticides, and products marked with corrosive, flammable, or toxic symbols.
