### City launches Extended Producer Responsibility Program

Exciting news! As of April 1, the City of Spruce Grove is participating in the Extended Producer Responsibility (EPR) program. The ERP program benefits communities by shifting the costs of recycling from local municipalities and taxpayers throughout Alberta, to producers and manufacturers.

This means more recycling options! Plastic clamshell containers and Tetra Paks can now be added to your blue bags, this includes items such as bakery and fruit packages, rotisserie chicken containers, and boxed soup or drink cartons. 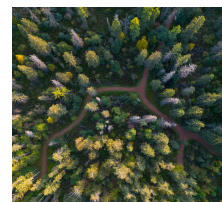
