Waste collection tips and cart storage reminders

As a responsible homeowner, remember to follow City guidelines when putting your black waste cart and green organics cart out for pick up to support safe and efficient neighbourhood waste collection.

Tips to keep waste pick up and storage moving smoothly:

- Place carts out by 7 a.m. on collection day and remove them by 11:59 p.m. the same day.
- Face carts towards the roadway and ensure lids are fully closed.
- Make sure carts have at least one metre of clearance on all sides.
- When carts are not out for collection, store them on your personal property.

Seasonal RV & ATV parking timelines

Whether you like to travel the Rockies in your RV or explore nature on your ATV, you need a place to park these vehicles throughout the year.

Starting April 15, RVs can be parked on private residential property. This includes motorhomes, boats, campers and travel trailers. ATVs with tracks, such as snowmobiles, will need to be moved and stored for the season by April 15.

Don't forget to keep sidewalks and roadways clear when parking RVs and ATVs to avoid blocking driver sightlines and to provide pedestrians enough room to walk by.
