Property tax notices have been mailed

City of Spruce Grove 2025 property tax notices have been mailed and payments are due June 30, 2025.

Property tax notices can also be viewed through Online Services at sprucegrove.org/OnlineServicesInfo or obtained at City Hall during business hours (Mon - Fri, 8:30 a.m. – 4:30 p.m.) for a printed copy. If you have any questions about your property taxes, please call 780-962-7634 ext. 119 or email propertytaxes@sprucegrove.org.

Failure to receive a tax notice does not affect the responsibility to pay taxes by the due date. Late payments will result in a 4.5 per cent penalty applied to the outstanding balance on the first of July, September and November.

Get crackin' with the City's urban hen keeping pilot program

The City of Spruce Grove is now in the second year of its urban hen keeping pilot program, which lets residents safely house three to six hens in their backyards. Residents interested in the program will need to apply for a hen keeping licence, follow guidelines to ensure hen health, and keep coops and enclosures in egg-cellent shape.

Hen keepers, similar to pet owners, are responsible for keeping enclosures in good condition to prevent smells, avoid attracting pests and respect nearby neighbours. Learn more about the program at sprucegrove.org/Hens.
