Seasonal News!

Lot Grading inspection season has officially opened as of May 1, 2025.

Please submit your inspection requests via **CityView** or send them to **lot.grading@sprucegrove.org**. Please check the City's **website** for updated information regarding lot grading.

Lot Grading Process

In the City of Spruce Grove, lot grading requires two steps:

- Rough Grade
- Final Grade

Both steps require the City to inspect the grade once complete. It is the **builder's responsibility** to communicate closely with homeowners to ensure rough grade approval is obtained **prior** to homeowners finishing their final grade.

Reminders

Construction Fire Safety Plan

Complete the **Construction Fire Safety Plan** and submit it with your building permit application. *Be sure to include all contact information.

Noise Limits and Site Cleanliness

Please review the **Community Standards Bylaw** in reference to Noise Limits and Construction Site Cleanliness.

Occupancy certificates

- Occupancy certificates are required **prior** to buildings being occupied.
- To avoid delays, ensure all trades permits are closed and compliant **prior** to final building inspections.
- Please review the Safety Codes Services Permit Bylaw and Schedule K of the Development Fees and Fines Bylaw that apply to occupancy.

Retaining Walls

- A building permit is required for retaining walls in certain circumstances such as:
 - Being directly connected to a building foundation or providing support for a building structure



- Being adjacent to public property or an access to a building
- Exceeding **1.2 meters** in height
- Retaining walls over **1.2 meters** in height will require structural engineering approval included in the permit application.
- Any retaining wall with an elevation difference between walking and adjacent surfaces
 exceeding 600 millimeters must have guards installed as per the National Building Code 2023 Alberta Edition.

Did you know?

If you are unable to request an inspection, please check for any open conditions on the permit using your **CityView** Portal account, such as:

- Outstanding Water and Sewer Service Connection inspection
- Incomplete or missing Construction Fire Safety Plan
- Outstanding signed Verification of Compliance (VOC)
- Any unpaid fees on the permit
