### **Property tax payments due** June 30, 2025

City of Spruce Grove 2025 property tax notices were mailed on May 14, 2025, and payments are due June 30, 2025.

Property tax notices can also be viewed through Online Services at sprucegrove.org/OnlineServicesInfo or obtained at City Hall during business hours (Mon - Fri, 8:30 a.m. - 4:30 p.m.).

Failure to receive a tax notice does not affect the responsibility to pay taxes by the due date. Late payments will result in a 4.5 per cent penalty applied to the outstanding balance on the first of July, September and November.
