Property maintenance helps create a cleaner, safer Spruce Grove—let's do it together

Maintaining your property helps keep our community clean and safe, creating a welcoming, attractive place for both residents and visitors to enjoy.

Last year, the City of Spruce Grove introduced the Community Standards Bylaw to provide property owners with clear guidance on property maintenance. This comes with plenty of perks, like being a good neighbour, preventing obstructions, reducing odours, keeping streets and alleys accessible, and showcasing your well-kept lawn!

Keep your property and neighbourhood safe and tidy with these tips:

- Remove outdoor obstructions like appliances and broken/unused vehicles.
- Mow grass regularly, manage noxious weeds and maintain naturalized yards.
- Reduce unwanted odours by securely storing excess waste, garbage and bottles.

Property tax payments due June 30, 2025

City of Spruce Grove 2025 property tax notices were mailed on May 14, 2025, and payments are due June 30, 2025.

Property tax notices can also be viewed through Online Services at sprucegrove.org/OnlineServicesInfo or obtained at City Hall during business hours (Mon - Fri, 8:30 a.m. – 4:30 p.m.).

Failure to receive a tax notice does not affect the responsibility to pay taxes by the due date. Late payments will result in a 4.5 per cent penalty applied to the outstanding balance on the first of July, September and November.
