Register to vote

Did you know you can check in advance to make sure you are registered to vote in the municipal election this fall? Find out if you are registered to vote by visiting voterlink.ab.ca and if you're not, you can easily register online until August 15! This information will provide the City of Spruce Grove with a list of eligible voters, but don't worry – if you arrive at a voting station and your name doesn't appear on the permanent electors register, you will also have an opportunity to register to vote at that time.
