## Even construction sites can be kept tidy!

Under the City's Community Standards Bylaw, builders are required to keep sites clean and safe within Spruce Grove. This includes:

- Keeping sites clean by properly storing building materials and equipment, using waste containers, and preventing mud or debris from spreading onto roads.
- Maintaining access to private properties, sidewalks and driveways.
- Following noise restriction rules construction is permitted from 7 a.m. to 10 p.m. (Monday to Saturday) and 10 a.m. to 10 p.m. (Sundays).

# Regular Council Meeting followed by Governance and Priorities Meeting Monday, August 18, 2025


