Driveway aids to be removed from streets

Driveway aids (also known as driveway ramps or curb ramps) must be removed from city streets by October 31, per Spruce Grove's Traffic Bylaw. When the snow comes, ramps can freeze to the road surface and get caught up in snow removal equipment causing costly repairs and delays for snow removal. Ramps can be placed on driveway curbs again starting May 1, 2026. Learn more at sprucegrove.org/DrivewayAids.
