SNOW REMOVAL IN SPRUCE GROVE



When the snow arrives in the City of Spruce Grove, our crews are ready to respond! Our comprehensive snow removal program keeps roads cleared to help ensure you can get where you need to go during the winter months.

Priority sequence

Snow removal is prioritized based on the most travelled roads in Spruce Grove, ensuring the most used roads are cleared first, helping to maintain traffic flow and road safety.

Snow routes

Snow routes are the main high-traffic roads typically found within neighbourhood subdivisions that connect to both larger arterial roads and smaller residential roads. These routes are identified by permanent signs. Parking on snow routes is permitted, until they are declared active.



When snow routes are activated, yellow signs are posted along the route to provide residents with 24 hours' notice to move their vehicles and any other obstructions from the street.

City Centre area

City Centre snow removal occurs on all local roadways in the area between Calahoo Road and King Street, and between Highway 16A and Mohr Avenue. It helps provide access to local businesses, homes, and public facilities such as City Hall.



When snow removal is scheduled, white signs are posted a minimum of 48 hours' in advance to give residents and businesses time to remove vehicles and other obstacles from the road.

Residential neighbourhood streets

Residential snow removal typically occurs when there has been a major snowfall and other higher priority roads have been cleared.



When residential snow removal is active, orange signs will be posted at the entrance to subdivisions at least 72 hours' in advance of when snow removal operations will start and when parking is not permitted. Each winter, the snow clearing rotation for residential snow removal changes with each neighbourhood moving up one place in the rotation.
