Council approves 2026-2028 Budget and Fiscal Plan

City Council is pleased to present the 2026-2028 Budget and Fiscal Plan, which invests in areas that are important to Spruce Grove residents, including improvements to transit reliability, core City services, and community safety.

The budget, which includes a 4.68 per cent tax increase, supports growth while also strengthening the City's existing services. It was approved by City Council during the December 8, 2025, Council meeting.

Right-of-ways

Did you know right-of-ways are important spaces that help keep our community services running safely and reliably? A right-of-way is the section of land next to the road and gives the City access to utilities for repairs and upgrades.

Right-of-ways should be kept as turfgrass to support easy access. Any items placed in the right-of-way are at the property owner's risk, and the City does not replace, or repair driveway finishes, decorative materials or landscaping located in these spaces.
