Residential street sweeping has started and will take place weekdays, weather permitting.

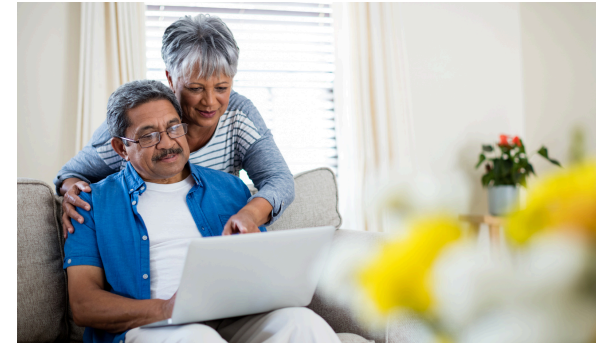
