City's newest piece of public art unveiled at Heavy Metal Place

A new public mural celebrating Spruce Grove's 40th anniversary of incorporation as a city has been unveiled at Heavy Metal Place.

Spruce Grove Roots and Seeds was created by artist Tyler Toews and co-designer Kayla Bellerose. The mural pays tribute to the community's agricultural roots and connects Spruce Grove's past, present and future in a vibrant, dynamic, three-dimensional art style.
