Invasive goldfish management strategy

The City of Spruce Grove has positively identified goldfish (*Carrassius auratus*) in the Easton stormwater management facility. After extensive consultation with Alberta Environment and Protected Areas, the City has initiated a comprehensive goldfish management strategy.
